With the heightened level of caution and mandatory social distancing rules in place due to the COVID-19 pandemic, we wanted to share with you the steps we have taken at Smith Chiropractic to ensure your safety. Our staff remains 100% committed to protecting you and preventing illness in our community.

- Social Distance Appointment Scheduling: This means limiting the appointment schedule so there are no more than 2 patients in the waiting area at a time. This also gives us ample time to sanitize treatment rooms after each patient.
- Facemasks: Facemasks are mandatory for office staff and all who enter the office.
- Temperature Check: Anyone entering the office will be required to have their temperature checked. Anyone with a fever of 100.3 or above will be asked to leave.
- Mandatory Handwashing: We ask that all patients clean their hands immediately when they enter the office, and before they leave.
- Payment Procedures: The credit card machine has been relocated so that patients may swipe their own card. Signatures on receipts are not required at this time. We can also hold a credit card on file if you would prefer to avoid payment transactions.

Cleaning procedures:

- Treatment Tables are wiped down between each patient with an anti-viral formula.
- We use a superior Medical Disinfectant, which kills 99.999% of Bacterial and Viral germs.
- We have antiviral hand soap and paper towels in our restrooms. Right now, we are insisting on handwashing or sanitizing upon entering and leaving the office.
- Doorknobs, counters and the restrooms are frequently and thoroughly cleaned & sanitized.
- The carpet is cleaned regularly.
- We have wall-mounted hand sanitizer in our entrance hall and anti-viral wipes and sanitizer in each treatment room for your personal use. There is an exi-towel dispenser at the door.

We continue to closely monitor this public health situation daily and provide our patients with the most current and vital information from the State and National sources.
